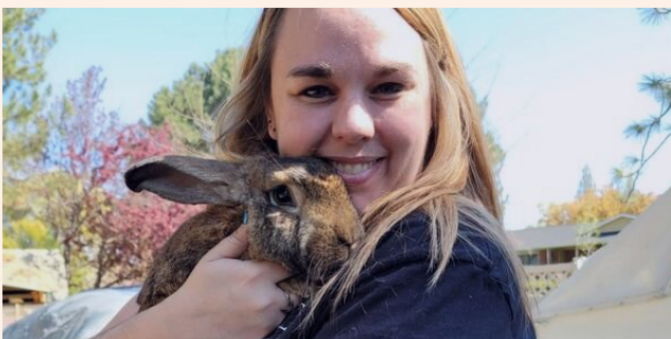


Charla, Kevin, Kathy, Lela, and Flopsy

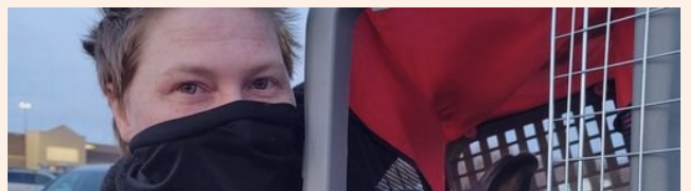


Hallie, Maddie, Mocha, and Sven
